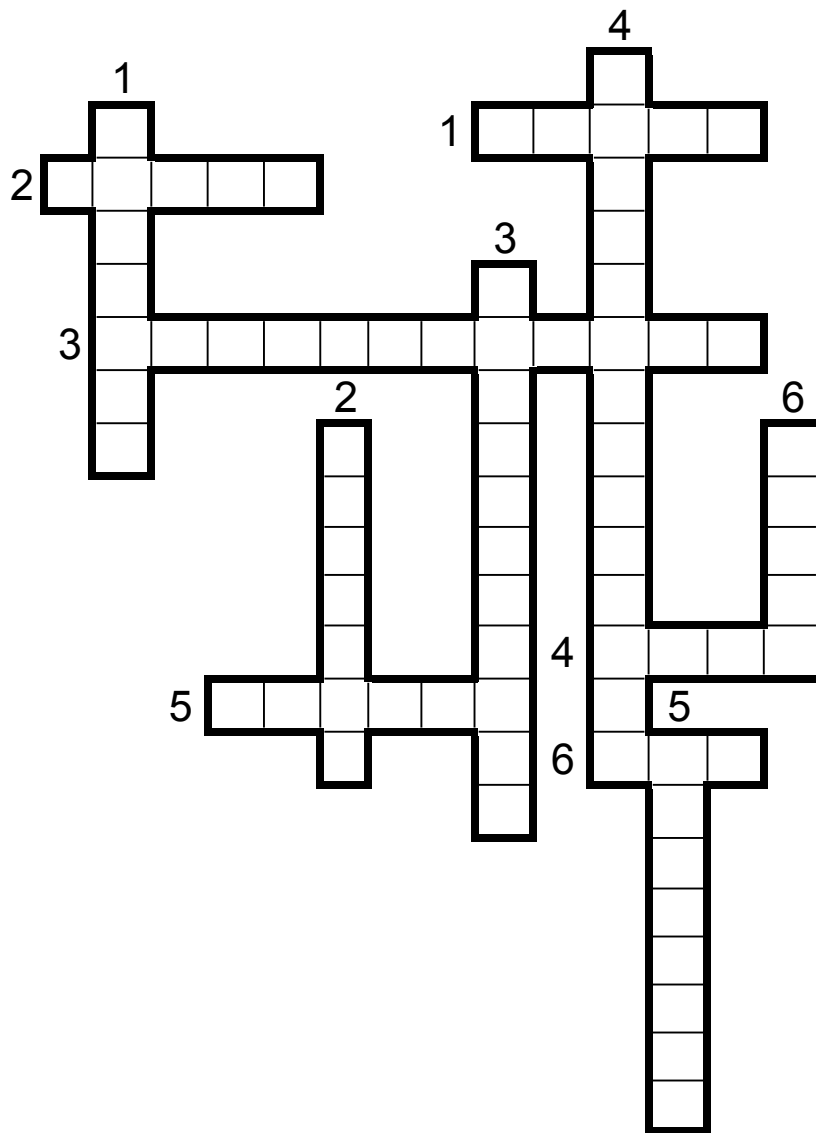


# Native American Crossword
